you are safe to stay in your apartment if the fire occurs elsewhere in the building. You must ensure the fire brigade are called. Your apartment is designed to be safe only for a limited period. If in doubt get out- call the fire brigade immediately. You must leave your apartment immediately if told to do so by the emergency services.

2.

if a fire occurs inside your apartment, leave it immediately. If possible close all apartment doors and windows behind you. Do not collect personal items. If you are on an upper floor and are unable to use the stairs DO NOT USE THE LIFTS. Move to the nearest stairway landing or to a neighbouring apartment and await arrival of the firebrigade

3.

ENSURE THE FIREBRIGADE ARE CALLED BY DIALING 999, USE A MOBILE PHONE OR CALL FROM ANOTHER APARTMENT OR BUILDING IF IT IS UNSAFE TO CALL FROM WITHIN YOUR APARTMENT

WARN EVERY ONE IN THE VICINITY, SHOUT FIRE

ENSURE THE FIREBRIGADE ARE CALLED BY DIALING 999
